No Opt Out of Testing Alpine Academy Charter High School

Accountability of student achievement is a primary mission at Alpine Academy Charter High School. Assessments assist Alpine in identifying student mastery of Nevada Academic Content Standards and support the determination whether students are equipped with the necessary knowledge and skills they need to be successful in college and career. Therefore, every student enrolled at Alpine Academy will participate in applicable academic assessments.

Alpine Academy does not recognize parent opt out or parent/student refusal to test. If a parent keeps his/her student home during mandatory testing, the school will respond as it would with any situation where a parent keeps a child out of school utilizing the progressive attendance policy and the test will be made up upon the student's return to school. If a student is at school and refuses to take the assessment, the student will be referred to administration for insubordination and progressive discipline for the student's refusal to participate in the assessment will be applied. Aligned with Alpine Academy's Progressive Discipline Policy, school administrators may also choose to not allow participation in after school activities such as clubs, athletics, and on field trips for students who refuse to participate in statewide assessments
